A Profile in EMPATHY THE MATHAI MATHEW FAMILY

Dr. Mathai Mathew began his journey in Mavelikkara, Kerala (Idavoor Puthen Veedu, Chennithala). During his college days at the University College, Trivandrum he was an active member of the MGOCSM Trivandrum Unit. In his early years, he dedicated himself to teaching at Catholicate College, Pathanamthitta igniting a spark for science in the hearts of countless students. His academic path led him across continents to Canada, where he pursued and completed a Ph.D. in theoretical chemistry. Following his doctoral work, Dr. Mathew joined the American Dental Association, USA.

Sara Mathew (Ollickal house, Vadasherikkara, Kerala) pursued her nursing degree with purpose. She courageously traveled to Canada, seeking new opportunities and a broader horizon. With unwavering determination, she moved to the United States, where her career blossomed at the National Institute of Health (NIH). There, she worked alongside some of the world's leading cancer research scientists.

Sonie Mathew, their son, inspired countless students to find their voice. Through every lesson and every note, he taught that music isn't just sound, it's therapy, it's community. But his love for the performing arts didn't stop in the classroom. Sonie was deeply involved in theater. What made Sonie truly extraordinary was how he used his gifts to uplift those who needed it most. He devoted himself to working with children with disabilities, especially those on the autism spectrum and with Asperger's Syndrome.

Together, the Mathew family shared a sacred bond with **MGRCB** – a place where compassion meets creativity, and where every person, regardless of ability, is embraced with dignity. Through their collective work, advocacy, and presence, **Dr. Mathew, Sara, and Sonie** want to shape MGRCB into not just a space—but a sanctuary.

Through their Will, they disbursed their worldly possessions not only to benefit the family but the most deserving brethren through MGRCB. We hope and pray that MGRCB carries forward the baton in earnest.

FORTY THIRD ANNUAL REPORT (FY 2025-26)

*"If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need

Respected President, Honorable Members and Beloved Well-wishers,

It is my bounden duty and privilege to present before you the 43rd Annual Report of Mar Gregorios Rehabilitation Centre for the Blind, for the year 2025-26.

Mar Gregorios Rehabilitation Centre for the Blind (**MGRCB**) is a charitable organization under the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church and is engaged in the rehabilitation of poor differently-abled persons. This noble venture was started in 1983 by the late lamented Philipose Mar Theophilus Metropolitan as a project of **Mar Gregorios Orthodox Christian Students Movement** (MGOCSM), the student wing of the Church. At that time the plan was to look after poor visually impaired (VI) people only. Later, in 1993, the services were extended to cover people with other types of infirmities such as orthopaedically handicapped (OH), hearing impaired (HI) and mentally challenged (MC). In the reporting year (2026), we have started caring for people suffering from kidney related diseases(KC), specifically for dialysis with the support of Sonie-Sara- Mathew Memorial Fund(a donation from Sara and Mathai Mathew Trust B). The area of operation at present consists of four village panchayats around Trivandrum city viz., Aruvikkara, Karakulam, Velland and Vilappil as also portions of Trivandrum Corporation which were previously Vattiyoorkavu and Kudappanakunnu panchayats, covering a total area of 114 sq. kilometers. The unique feature of **MGRCB** is that **the rehabilitation work is community based, which enables the beneficiaries to live and work in their own homes and environment**. Our Community Workers regularly visit their houses and render the necessary services. This system has the distinct advantage that the differently-abled persons are not dislocated from their homes; they continue to get help & support from their families and neighbours.

We provide medical, economic and social rehabilitation services to these poor differently-abled persons and the details are given below.

The rehabilitation work commences with the identification of needy differently-abled persons through field surveys. Our community workers then regularly visit them and give them counselling to enable them to come out of their shells of disappointment, helplessness and superstitions. The persons who need medical treatment are taken to various government hospitals in Trivandrum city by our workers. The medical treatment includes providing medicines, physiotherapy, surgery and medical equipments. During the year, 1030 medical examinations were facilitated. Medicines were given in 1605 cases; 210 visually impaired persons were given spectacles and two blind persons were given white canes. Aids and equipments were given to 126 orthopaedically handicapped persons. In addition, 6 cataract operations were also arranged. 17 kidney patients were identified through field survey for receiving monthly financial assistance to cover dialysis related expenses.

After meeting their immediate medical needs, we try to rehabilitate the differently-abled persons economically. Several counselling sessions are usually required to make them receptive and self-confident. Vocational training programmes are arranged depending upon the client's aptitude and ability. Selected clients are then encouraged to start self-employment projects such as tea shop, vegetable shop, petty shop, electronic repair shop, provision store, tailoring, goat rearing, chicken rearing, envelope making etc. The financial assistance required for starting a project is provided by MGRCB. The income generated through such self-employment projects, though relatively small, makes the differently-abled person self-confident, happy and enthusiastic, as the members of the family and community start to view them as useful and participating members of the society. During the reporting year, we have extended financial assistance to three people for starting self-employment schemes.

Educational assistance was given to poor differently-abled children and to children of differently-abled persons. There are many such children who are eager to learn but do not have the means. During the year, fresh applications were collected for Supplementary Educational Assistance and assistance provided to 29 such students in the form of note books, tuition fees, hostel fees, uniforms, and transportation charges.

MGRCB has also been helping the differently-abled persons to get disability certificates, pension, bus passes, railway passes, etc. from various Government and other agencies.

The clients are being taken to Medical College, Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences & Technology, Community Health Centers (CHCs) Public Health Centers (PHCs), Mental Health Hospital, Regional Institute of Ophthalmology (Trivandrum) and the like for regular and specialised care. Field-visits of doctors were also conducted wherever necessary. We thankfully acknowledge the service rendered by Dr. C. K. John (Peroorkada Thekkan Parumala Valiyapally) and Dr. Mathew John (Vattiyookavu St. Peters and St. Pauls Church) for the field visit.

Differently-abled persons are our brethren and we have a responsibility to do whatever is possible to alleviate their miseries and live with honour. In this context, MGRCB's role is significant and we need the support of all to carry on this noble work with greater vigour.

Management Meetings

During this financial year 12 (twelve) monthly Executive Committee meetings and two special Executive Committee meetings were conducted. H.G. Dr. Abraham Mar Seraphim Metropolitan, President, presided one of the special Executive Committee meetings.

Finance & Accounts

The accounts of MGRCB as on 31st March 2026 has been finalized, and approved by the Executive Committee meeting held on 21st May 2026. The accounts have been duly audited by M/s Thomaskutty P. C. & Co. as on 16-6-2026. The audit report is annexed with this report. During the year, MGRCB has a total income of ₹58,79,483.00 and total expenditure of ₹59,49,025.69, with excess of expenditure over income of ₹69,542.69.

Case Review Committee (CRC) Meetings

Every Tuesday, CRC meeting is conducted to review the work done by our field staff during the previous week. This is followed by planning for the immediately following week, month and quarter. The review is done by the office bearers and Executive Committee members. MGRCB places on record the contributions of Director, Jt. Directors, Secretary, Jt. Secretary, Jt. Treasurer, Revd. Fr. Geevarghese Mekkatt, Mr. D. Varghese, Mrs Susan Mathew, Mr.P.C. George, Adv. George Mathai and Mr. Abhilash Jacob Varghese.

Income Tax and FCRA Registrations

During this financial year, MGRCB renewed the Income Tax (12A) registration for 10 years (till 31-03-2036) and Income Tax Exemption (80G) for 5 years (till 31-03-2031). MGRCB places on record the appreciation for Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Secretary and the Chartered Accountants for their valuable efforts. Our FCRA registration is valid till 30-09-2028.

Sonie-Sara- Mathew Memorial Fund

Sara and Mathai Mathew Trust B of Maryland, USA, had apportioned a part of the trust fund for giving to MGRCB. The Trustee and legal representative of the Trust had contacted our office and donated Rs 3.05 crores during the financial year, with guiding conditions for the usage of the fund. We fondly remember Mr. Mathai Mathew, Mrs Sara Mathew and their son Sonie Mathew; their kind act; and pray for their souls.

CSR Funds

Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) aims to contribute to societal goals of a philanthropic, or charitable nature by engaging in, with, or supporting professional service volunteering through community development, administering monetary grants to non-profit organizations for the public benefit. M/s HLL LifeCare Ltd. and M/s LIC Golden Jubilee Foundation has donated Rs 12,00,000/- and Rs 14,16,878/- respectively to our Centre from their CSR allocation. Using these funds, we replaced our old vehicles – Tata Winger and Tata Sumo Victa with two Force Trax (12+D). We are extremely grateful for their generous continued support to us.

C. Social Rehabilitation Services

Supplementary Educational Assistance Programme

Twenty nine students were given assistance under this programme during the year. They were provided with text books, note books, bags, umbrellas, tuition/hostel fee etc. In addition, an orientation programme was conducted for the students who are supported by us.

D. Training Programme

Many of the clients require retraining even in activities of daily living as part of their medical recovery. During the reporting year, 22 such persons were trained. A few others require guidance in physical exercises to improve their mobility. We have helped 56 such individuals during the reporting period.

E. Food Security Programme - Jubilee Daily Food(JDF)

Some of our clients, have absolutely no source of income or have little to spare for nutritious food. Started in the Jubilee year of MGRCB, the food security programme aims to fill this gap by providing food kits with essential supplies including rice, lentils and spices.

In the beginning of the financial year, 28 families were supported through the JDF programme. Executive Committee members and some of the well-wishers accompanied the staff during the monthly distribution. We thank the efforts of all that labored in the distribution.

Eye Camps

Three free eye-camps were conducted across our service areas. Doctors and paramedical staff from the Regional Institute of Ophthalmology, Trivandrum extended their services in these camps.

PAPER CRAFT UNIT

We had a paper craft unit at MGRCB to enable the differently-abled persons to get engaged in productive work. Kerala Kaumudi, Muthoot Mercantile Ltd and Pentecostal Mission Trust, Trivandrum were some of the enterprises that gave regular orders. The advancement in technologies and competition from factory made products have significantly impacted the viability of our unit. The number of clients who benefitted from the therapy provided through this activity also reduced to a few. After conducting a cost-benefit analysis, and future availability of qualified persons to manage this operation, it was decided to close down the paper craft unit.

IMPORTANT EVENTS OF 2025-26

Career Guidance and Supplementary Education program

One of the flagship programs of MGRCB, conducted at the beginning of every school-year, is a programme for child beneficiaries and children of our beneficiaries. This year's program was held on 14-6-2025(Saturday) from 10:00 AM at our Centre. Mrs. Geetha Kumari Teacher, former Principal of PSNM Government Higher Secondary School, was the Chief Guest. After a captivating motivational class, school aid like bags, stationery, and some amount of monetary assistance were distributed by the dignitaries and office bearers.

Snehasangamam

Snehasangamam was held on Saturday, 23rd August at our Centre from 10:00 AM. Shri. S.M. Vijayanand(former Chief Secretary, Government of Kerala) was the chief guest and more than 50 beneficiaries and their family members attended this program.

Various medical equipments and auxiliary devices were distributed to the needy. Some of the clients presented cultural programs. Members of the Peroorkada Bapuji library presented a "reading theatre" drama. The program ended with Onasadya for all.

In the months that have five Fridays, the city parishes of the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church conduct a combined prayer meeting. Our Centre was opened for the conduct of the prayer on 29 August 2025. Participants from about a dozen parishes attended the meeting, and the main message was given by Revd. Fr. C.V. Ninan, Asst Vicar, Nalanchira St. Mary's Orthodox church. It gave an opportunity to present the Centre and its varying activities to the attendees.
