Report of Activities

Activities - April 2025

Community Rehabilitation:- 206 clients where cared through 538 visits by our social workers. Medicines were supplied to 122 clients under Continuous Medicine Supply scheme. 69 clients benefited through 14 PMR visits.

Jubilee Daily Food Programme: Food kits containing 11 items were distributed to 28 clients.

Routine Activities:- 5 CRC meetings, one executive committee meeting where held.

Client Update:- 1 new client was added and 2 clients passed away.

Activities - May 2025

Community Rehabilitation:- 201 clients where cared through 538 visits by our social workers. Medicines were supplied to 122 clients under Continuous Medicine Supply scheme. 50 clients benefited through 8 PMR visits. No doctor field visit happened during the month.

Jubilee Daily Food Programme: Food kits containing 11 items were distributed to 28 clients.

Routine Activities:- 4 CRC meetings, one executive committee where held.

Client Update: 1 new client was added and 1 client passed away.

Activities - June 2025

Community Rehabilitation:- 233 clients where cared through 510 visits by our social workers. Equipments were given to 7 clients and 3 spectacles. Medicines were supplied to 134 clients under Continuous Medicine Supply scheme. 46 clients benefited through 8 PMR visits. Dr. C. K. John visited eight clients during the month.

Social Rehabilitation: Continues the financial assistance to 28 students through Supplementary Education Assistance.

Jubilee Daily Food Programme: Food kits containing 11 items were distributed to 28 clients.
